WAIVER OF CLAIMS AND DAMAGES

- I. **Participation in Preble STINGCANCER Stomp and Stroll.** I/we are the Participant or the parent(s)/legal guardian(s) of the Participant named above ("Participant") (hereafter referred to together as the "Releasing Parties"). I/we understand that Participant is voluntarily participating in the Preble STINGCANCER Stomp and Stroll ("Event") to be held at Green Bay Preble High School. As part of this Event, Participants will be walking around the track at Preble High School and may be subject to unpredictable weather conditions, uneven terrain and other trail conditions, traffic, and limited access to immediate medical assistance. The Event has the inherent risk of falls, contact with Event participants or volunteers or with vehicles, the effects of the weather, and course conditions, etc.
- II. **Acknowledgment of Risk.** In exchange for the Participant's participation in the Event, the Releasing Parties acknowledge and fully understand that there are inherent risks, including the acts and omissions of the Participant, other Participants, or Event partners, associated with the Event and that all inherent risks cannot be described as part of this document.
- III. **Waiver of Rights and Release of Liability.** The Releasing Parties hereby release, waive and discharge the Green Bay Area Public School District, Preble STINGCANCER, Event timers, sponsors, and organizers, and their employees, agents, representatives, affiliates, volunteers, successors and assigns (hereinafter referred to as "Releasees"), from liability claims and demands of negligence on the part of the Releasees, its employees, agents and volunteers; personal injury; bodily harm; injury to or loss of property; emotional injury; or loss of consortium; arising in connection with participation in the Event, including, but not limited to, those risks described in paragraph #1 above; providing, however, that this waiver and release does not include injury, damage, or loss as a result of the intentional or reckless acts of the Releasees, its agents, employees or volunteers.
- IV. **Limitation.** I/we further acknowledge that any claim I/we might be able to make against the Releasees as a result of any damage, injury, or death that may occur because of my/our child's participation in the Event is limited by the applicable immunities and limitations of Wis. Stat. § 893.80, which limits my/our ability to file claims against the Releasees, the procedures for doing so, and the amount of damages any of the Releasing Parties would be able to collect from the Releasees or its insurers. This waiver explicitly excludes potential liability for any intentional acts that may result in the injury of a participant.
- V. **Indemnification and Hold Harmless.** The Releasing Parties hereby protect, indemnify, and hold harmless the Releasees and its respective officers, officials, employees and agents against any and all losses, damages, monetary awards and expenses, including all costs and attorneys' fees, incurred in connection with any and all claims of negligence on the part of the Releasees, its employees and agents and volunteers, brought by the Releasing Parties, or any of them, or his or her heirs, successors, assigns, and legal representatives, for any injury, death, illness, disease, or damage to property, arising from or connected with participation in the Event. The indemnification and hold harmless agreement does not include losses, damages, monetary awards and expenses as a result of the intentional or reckless acts of the Releasees, its employees and agents and volunteers.
- VI. **Photo Release.** I/we grant Releasees full permission to use images, recordings or any other record of Participant while participating in the Event in any medium. I/we agree that Participant's name and identity may be revealed therein or by descriptive text or commentary.
- VII. **Render of Aid.** I/we state that Participant has no medical condition that would inhibit participation in the Event and agree to follow the direction of the Event staff members. I/we grant Event staff members permission to render first aid and/or obtain medical treatment deemed necessary on the Event premises or prior to transport to a medical facility for further treatment.
- VIII. **Miscellaneous.** The parties agree that the provisions of this "Waiver of Claims and Damages" ("Agreement") shall be deemed severable, and that the invalidity or unenforceability of any one or more of the provisions or clauses shall not affect the validity or enforceability of the other provisions or clauses except as specifically set forth herein. The terms of this Agreement constitute the entire agreement and understanding between the parties. This Agreement is made pursuant to and shall be construed under the laws of the state of Wisconsin.
- IX. **Opportunity to Negotiate.** You are encouraged to carefully review the contents of this Agreement and take time to review it. DO NOT SIGN this Agreement unless you understand and agree to the terms and conditions of this Agreement. If you wish to NEGOTIATE any of the terms of this Agreement for modifications, deletions, or additions, please contact Daniel Retzki at 920-272-7046 prior to signing and executing this Agreement. If you do not contact the above-named contact prior to signing and executing this Agreement, the Releasees understand that you are accepting the terms and conditions as set forth above, and that you do not wish to pursue any further negotiations regarding the terms and conditions of this Agreement.

I CERTIFY THAT I HAVE READ THIS WAIVER OF CLAIMS AND DAMAGES AND THAT I UNDERSTAND THAT I AM GIVING UP SUBSTANTIAL RIGHTS AND ASSUMING SUBSTANTIAL RESPONSIBILITIES BY SIGNING IT, AND THAT I SIGN IT VOLUNTARILY.
